Motion by Anderson to reorganize the Police Commission and approve two new appointments, Angela Grosskreutz and Leif Ringstad, second by Schradle. Voice vote: Ayes-6 Nays-0 Motion carried (Continuing Commission members are Brenda Ketz, Jim Kuntz, and Randy Slack)

Motion by Anderson to take Agenda Item #4 from the table, second by Bartz. Voice vote: Ayes-6 Nays-0 Motion carried.

Motion by Schradle to enter into a Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the Village of Clear Lake for the period Sept. 20, 2017 through Dec. 31, 2017, second by Casarez. Voice vote: Ayes-6 Nays-0 Motion carried.
