Motion by Schradle to enter into closed session proceedings under WI Statutes 19.85(1)(c) to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercised responsibility and to consider issues related to employee insurance benefits and staffing levels, second by Robinson. Motion by Schradle to return to open session, second by Robinson. Roll call vote: Casarez-Yes Scharmer-Yes Drinkman-Yes Robinson-Yes Schradle-Yes Berghammer-Yes Motion carried.

By affirmation, the board instructed Berghammer to speak with DPW Director Donath to share the board's decision regarding unused vacation days and its recommendation to use a portion of them before Dec. 31.

Motion to adjourn by Drinkman at 8:15 PM, second by Robinson. Voice vote: Ayes-6 Nays-0 Motion carried.
